

Upcycled Side Table

Description:

This upcycled side table would add great counter space in a bathroom or as an end table in a tight space. You can feel great about upcycling and look great adding a funky eclectic vibe to your space.

Materials: 1 Drawer 4 spindles (or legs of your choice) 1 5/8" Screws Paint Contact Paper	Tools: Paint Brush Drill Compact Driver

The Step by Step:

1. Place one leg in a corner of the drawer and press it tightly. Drill a pilot hole through side drawer and into the leg. Follow by drilling in a screw to secure leg in place.
2. Repeat step 1 with each leg.
3. Once all four legs are attached, stand table up and drill a pilot hole through the top of the drawer into each leg, then add a screw to each corner.
4. Now, if desired, paint each side to match the face of the drawer, as well as the top edge.
5. After the paint has dried, cut contact paper to size and apply.
